It is moved to approve the following resolution declaring a case of urgent necessity exists in the repair/construction of the Softball batting cage facility at the Unioto Outdoor Athletic Complex and authorizing the Union Scioto Local School District Board of Education to proceed without advertisement and bidding as identified in O.R.C. 3313.46.

Resolution Declaring an Urgent Necessity repair/construction of the Softball batting cage facility

WHEREAS, repair/construction of the Softball batting cage facility at the Unioto Outdoor Athletic Complex is needed as soon as possible due to safety concerns, and

WHEREAS, compliance with the procedures for the advertisement of bids and receiving of bids prescribed by O.R. C. 3313.46 would delay the commencement of the project for an excessive period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Union Scioto Local School District, County of Ross, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. It is found and determined pursuant to O.R.C. 33133.46 that there is an urgent necessity for the repair/construction of the of the Softball batting cage facility at the Unioto Outdoor Athletic Complex.

Section 2. It is further found and determined that compliance with the procedures of the bidding process prescribed by O.R.C. 3313.46 would delay the commencement of the needed repair for an excess period.

Section 3. The Treasurer/ Superintendent of this Board is hereby authorized to present quotes obtained for the repair/construction of the of the Softball batting cage facility at the Unioto Outdoor Athletic Complex and in accordance with the exceptions to competitive bidding in O.R. C. 3313.46 to procure proposals for the work described.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this board concerning and relating to the adoption of the resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the board, and that all deliberations of this board and of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were adopted in meetings open to the public, in accordance to the law.
